About the Program

Since 1939, Purity Spring Resort has welcomed boys and girls to its fun and exciting Ski Camp. Wearing leather boots strapped to wooden skis, early skiers created many tracks--and many smiles-- on these friendly slopes. When King Pine officially opened in 1962, countless individuals had already traveled to these hills to discover the thrill and camaraderie of skiing. Today, Ski Camp maintains its long-standing tradition of high quality instruction within a lively, social setting.

Campers are split into ski/snowboard classes based on ability. Counselors, many also having been campers, act as instructors. Off the slopes, counselors oversee nightly activities, socials, meals and dormitory life. While boys and girls mix on the slopes, during dances and movies, and in the dining hall, they live with their friends in gender-specific dorms. A counselor-to-camper ratio of 1:7 ensures that support and supervision are available at all times.

Boys and girls come to Ski Camp to ski, board, skate, swim, sled, dance, laugh and learn together. For the most part, campers are in constant motion... enthusiasm prevails! Friendships and fun are a huge part of this Ski Camp experience. We hope to share this experience with you! There is no doubt that campers will create many new tracks-- and many new smiles-- together this winter at Purity Spring Resort's 2007 Ski Camp.

Tuition and Fees

Tuition for the 2007 Ski Camp is \$695 and includes lodging, meals, lessons and program. We recommend that each child brings some pocket money for snacks and miscellaneous items. Transportation and rentals are not included.
