Since 1939, Purity Spring Resort has welcomed boys and girls to its fun and exciting Ski & Snowboard Camp. Campers are split into ski/snowboard classes based on ability. Counselors, many also having been campers, act as instructors. While boys and girls mix on the slopes, during dances, movies and in the dining hall, they live with their friends in gender-specific dorms. A staff-to-camper ratio of 1:4 ensures that support and supervision are available at all times.
